



2020/21 grant fund awards July 2020 & January 2021

For the 2020/21 grant fund period (July 2020 and January 2021), 20 organisations received grants ranging from £100 to £1,343 and totalling £10,620 which is 82% of the 2020/21 grant fund of £13,000.

The remaining 18%/£2,380 will be used for any emergency community needs in the coming months with any remainder being added to the grant allocation fund for financial year 2021-22.

The Parish Council received a total of 24 applications totalling £16,252, an average request of £677.17 per applicant.

January 2021

10 organisations received grants ranging from £100 to £1,343 and totalling £6,520 which is 50% of the 2020/21 grant fund of £13,000. The remaining 18%/£2,380 will be used for any emergency community needs in the coming months with any remainder being added to the grant allocation fund for financial year 2021-22.

The Parish Council received a total of 11 applications totalling £6,520, an average request of £592.73 per applicant.

10 organisations received grants ranging from £250 to £500 and totalling £4,100 which is 32% of the 2020/21 grant fund of £13,000. The remaining 68.46%/£8,900 will be allocated in January 2021.

The Parish Council received a total of 13 applications totalling £9,732, an average request of £748.62 per applicant.
