11 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs Katie Dover, Andy Fish, Ian Leake, Amanda McLean & Kiran Meka.

12 **DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS**

Cllr Doyle declared an interest in agenda item on 7.2 Consultation with Allotment Holders as an allotment holder.

13 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

None.

14 REPORTS FOR DECISION

14.1 Joining the National Allotment Society

It was proposed by Cllr Doyle and seconded by Cllr Ellis and **RESOLVED** to approve the recommendation for Binfield Parish Council to join the National Allotment Society at a cost of £55 (plus £1.00 joining fee) to be funded from the Subscriptions budget line.

14.2 Tree Survey Report & Findings

Following Council approval to spread the surveys of parish owned trees over a 2 year period, the contractor was appointed to carry out their assessments of trees in Foxley Fields, York Road, Red Rose Allotments and Mutton Oaks. The last survey took place in April 2023. The condition of the trees has been based on a visual inspection made at ground level. The results of the survey identified work required on four trees. Three quotes from local contractors were obtained. It was proposed by ClIr Doyle and seconded by ClIr Day and **RESOLVED** to appoint Contractor 2 to complete the work, at the cost of £1,080.00 with the funds coming from budget line 21/5 Tree budget.

14.3 Plans for Border Area on Foxley Fields

The border area which runs along the front of the tennis courts in Foxley Fields has not been managed well. The original shrubs and plants, planted by a previous contractor, did not survive due to the runoff from the tennis courts and possibly getting damaged by passers-by walking on them.

It was proposed by Cllr Doyle and seconded by Cllr Day and **RESOLVED** to appoint a contractor to improve the border area and install a drainage system along the length of the tennis courts, at a cost of £3,770.00 to be funded from Open Spaces Maintenance Reserves.

14.4 Potential Autumn/Winter Ground Works

The current work schedule with the grounds' maintenance contractor consists of regular grass cuts in all the parish owned open spaces, with additional hedge works, spraying etc. to be agreed on an ad hoc basis. The Amenity Officer is now looking towards Q3 and Q4 and has identified several tasks that will need to be completed over the Autumn/Winter months.

It was proposed by Cllr Doyle and seconded by Cllr Ellis and **RESOLVED** to approve the recommended works be carried out by the contractor at a cost of £5,190 to be taken from approved 21/1 Open Spaces Contract budget line.

14.5 <u>Maintenance Works Required to the Footpath Around Wicks Green</u>
